

# List Users

---

Retrieve a list of users.

## ⚠ Attention

---

To prevent system performance issues that could occur due to large user databases, you must pass the `page` and `count` parameters to list paged results or the `filter` parameter to return results that match the filter criteria.

---

## Query Parameters

---

### filter (string)

- **Enum:** "username", "name.familyname", "name.givenname"
  - **Example:** `filter=name.familyname eq Admin or username eq sysadmin or name.givenname eq System`
  - **The criteria to filter the users list:**
    - `username` – The username of the user
    - `name.givenname` – The first name of the user
    - `name.familyname` – The last name of the user
  - **Supported operators:**
    - `eq` (equals)
    - `or` (match any of the specified criteria)
    - `and` (match all criteria simultaneously)
  - **Example Queries:**
    - Retrieve a single user: `?filter=username eq sysadmin`
    - Retrieve multiple users: `?filter=username eq sysadmin or username eq subadmin or username eq jdoe`
  - Returns all data for users that meet the filter criteria unless refined using the `properties` or `excludedProperties` parameters.

### properties (string)

- **Enum:**  
"meta", "name", "manager", "addresses", "emails", "schemas", "username", "timezone",  
"active", "employeeNumber", "organization", "department", "jobTitle"
  - **Example:** `properties=schemas,emails`
  - The user properties to include in the return. Only use this parameter with the `filter` parameter.
  - **⚠ Note:** The return only includes specified properties and the following default data:  
`activePassword`, `activeEsig`, `changeNextLogin`, `siteId`, `internalId`, and `userId`.
  - **⚠ Tip:** Separate multiple properties with a comma. Do not include spaces.

### excludedProperties (string)

- **Enum:**  
"meta", "name", "manager", "addresses", "emails", "schemas", "username", "timezone",  
"active", "employeeNumber", "organization", "department", "jobTitle"
  - **Example:** `excludedProperties=schemas,emails`
  - The user properties to exclude from the return. Only use this parameter with the `filter` parameter.
  - **⚠ Tip:** Separate multiple properties with a comma. Do not include spaces.
  - **⚠ Note:** If both `excludedProperties` and `properties` are provided, `excludedProperties` takes precedence.

### page (integer <int32>)

- **Example:** `page=1`
- The page number for which to return results. Use this with the `count` parameter.

- **Note:**

- This endpoint allows either paged results (`page` and `count`) or filtered results (`filter`).
- Using both `page` and `filter` in the same request will result in an error.

- **Tip:** Use the `filter` parameter if you know the first name, last name, or username of the users you are trying to retrieve.

## count (integer <int32>)

- **Example:** `count=100`
- The number of items returned per page. Use this with the `page` parameter.

## Return

Returns a `UserList` object that contains `User` objects.

      "name": "John Doe",  
      "activePassword": true,  
      "activeEsig": true,  
      "changeNextLogin": false,  
      "siteId": 12345678910,  
      "internalId": 123456789,  
      "userId": "JDOE",

        "department": "Accounting"  
      }  
    }  
  ]  
}
```
